### About Neighbourhood Padel

Neighbourhood Padel is opening a new padel venue in the heart of Digbeth, Birmingham. Our aim is to make padel the heartbeat of the neighbourhood by creating a welcoming, social and high-quality place to play, learn and connect.

The coaching programme will be a central part of the venue. We want coaching that helps people improve, enjoy the game and feel part of the club from their first session.

### About the role

This role will begin on a flexible, as-and-when basis while we build the coaching programme. There are no guaranteed weekly hours at launch, although regular coaching opportunities may develop quickly as demand grows.

Coaches will deliver padel sessions within the Neighbourhood Padel coaching structure. This means using our session formats, coaching standards, safeguarding expectations and customer experience principles.

The role is suited to an ambitious coach who wants to improve, learn from strong coach education support, work with beginner and improver players, and grow with the venue over time.

### What you will do

- Deliver high-quality padel coaching sessions for beginner and improver players.
- Support Intro to Padel sessions, beginner courses, clinics, socials and events.
- Deliver private lessons where appropriate and aligned to venue demand.
- Work within the Neighbourhood Padel coaching framework, session structure and delivery standards.
- Create a safe, inclusive and welcoming environment for all players.
- Help players understand the game, improve quickly and enjoy coming back.
- Take feedback and mentoring positively to keep improving your coaching.
- Represent the Neighbourhood Padel brand professionally on and off court.

- A qualified padel coach, with strong padel experience and a clear willingness to work within our padel coaching approach.
- A coach who wants to develop, not just deliver sessions.
- A clear, confident communicator who connects well with beginners and social players.
- Someone who can deliver structured, engaging and professional sessions.
- A reliable, organised person who is comfortable being part of a wider venue team.
- Someone who understands that the player experience matters as much as the technical content.
- Availability for weekdays, evenings and weekends, although hours will depend on demand.
